| 6 | Child Sacrifice | Not to engage in any form of child abuse (<i>Sanhedrin</i> , RF.2, SG.22) |
| 7 | Incantation | Not to employ any forms of black magic (<i>Sanhedrin</i> , RF.3, SG.23) |
| 8 | Superstition | Not to make or act on calculations of "lucky" and "unlucky" times based on superstitious beliefs or other omens (<i>Sanhedrin</i> , RF.4, SG.24) |
| 9 | Divination | (<i>Sanhedrin</i> , RF.5, SG.25) |
| 10 | Witchcraft | (<i>Sanhedrin</i> , RF.6, SG.26) |
| 11 | Charms & Concoctions | Not to produce or use idolatrous charms, potions, brews, and incense (<i>Sanhedrin</i> , RF.7, SG.27) |
| 12 | Channeling Deceased Ancestors (Ov) | Not to worship or attempt communication with deceased ancestors (<i>Sanhedrin</i> , RF.8, SG.28) |
| 13 | Channeling the Dead (Yidoni) | Not to seek knowledge from the deceased through idolatrous means (<i>Sanhedrin</i> , RF.9, SG.29) |
| 14 | Necromancy (Doresh Metim) | (<i>Sanhedrin</i> , RF.10, SG.30) |
